## **1. Microfinance and Financial Inclusion/S. Teki**



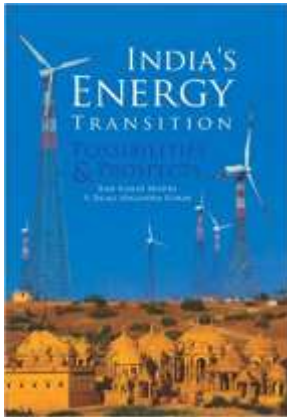

## **2. India's Energy Transition: Possibilities and Prospects/Ram Kumar Mishra**



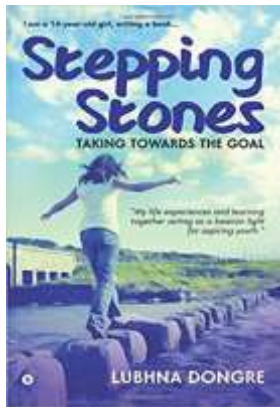

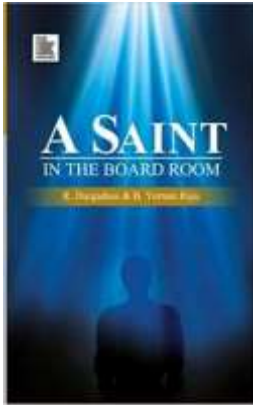

#### **4. A Saint in the Board Room/ R. Durgadoss**



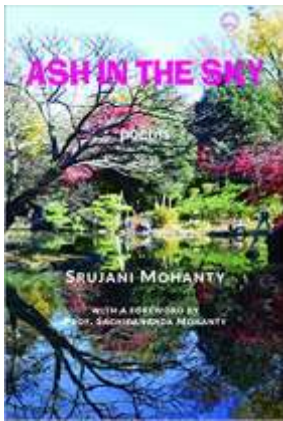
