**G. S.R. 315.**—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Planning Commission (Joint Adviser) Recruitment Rules, 2012 and Planning Commission (Deputy Adviser) Recruitment Rules, 2012, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules, regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Joint Adviser and Deputy Adviser in the NITI Aayog, namely:—

- 1. Short title and commencement.**—(1) These rules may be called the NITI Aayog, Joint Adviser and Deputy Adviser, Group 'A' Posts Recruitment Rules, 2018.  
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Application.**—These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (1) of the schedule annexed to these rules.
- 3. Number of posts, classification and level in pay matrix.**—The number of the said posts, their classification and the level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.
- 4. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc.**—The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.
- 5. Disqualification.**—No person,—
  - who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
  - who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person.

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 6. Power to relax.**—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 7. Saving.**—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of the age limit and other concessions required to be provided for candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with other orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Officers of the Central Government or State Governments or Union territories or recognised Universities or Research Institutions or Public Sector Undertakings or Autonomous Organisations or Statutory Organisations:—
(a) (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre or department; or (ii) with five years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis in posts in level-12 in the pay matrix or equivalent in the parent cadre or department; and
(b) possessing the educational qualifications and experience as prescribed in Annexure-I.
<b>Note 1:</b> There shall be flexibility to fill up the posts either by Joint Adviser or Deputy Adviser depending upon the eligibility of the applicants, however, number of vacancies to be filled up in the grade of Joint Adviser and Deputy Adviser shall be indicated at the time of submission of proposal to the Union Public Service Commission.

**Note 2:** The Departmental Deputy Adviser of the NITI Aayog in level-12 in the pay matrix with five years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis and possessing the educational qualifications and experience as prescribed in the Annexure-I and having successfully completed 2-4 weeks of training in relevant fields or area as specified by NITI Aayog will also be considered along with outsiders and if a Departmental Deputy Adviser is selected for appointment to the post, it will be treated as having been filled by promotion.

**Note 3:** Period of deputation (including short-term contract) including period of deputation (including short-term contract) in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisations or Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed five years.

**Note 4:** The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation (including short-term contract) shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

**Deputy Adviser:**

Officers of the Central Government or State Governments or Union territories or recognised Universities or Research Institutions or Public Sector Undertakings or Autonomous organisations or Statutory organisations:—

- (a) (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre or department; or
- (ii) with five years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis in posts in level-11 in the pay matrix or equivalent in the parent cadre or department; and
- (b) possessing the educational qualifications and experience as prescribed in Annexure-I.

**Note 1:** There shall be flexibility to fill up the posts either by Joint Adviser or Deputy Adviser depending upon the eligibility of the applicants, however, number of vacancies to be filled up in the grade of Joint Adviser and Deputy Adviser shall be indicated at the time of submission of proposal to Union Public Service Commission.

**Note 2:** The Departmental Senior Research Officer of the NITI Aayog in level-11 in the pay matrix with five years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis and possessing the educational qualifications and experience as prescribed in the Annexure-I and having successfully completed 2-4 weeks of training in relevant fields or area as specified by NITI Aayog will also be considered along with outsiders and if a Departmental Senior Research Officer is selected for appointment to the post, it will be treated as having been filled by promotion.

**Note 3:** Period of deputation (including short-term contract) including period of deputation (including short-term contract) in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation or Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed four years.

**Note 4:** The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation (including short-term contract) shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

**ANNEXURE 1**

**Essential Educational Qualification:**

Masters' degree in any discipline or MBBS or degree in Engineering or Technology from a recognised University or passed in sections 'A' and 'B' of the institution examinations of the Institute of Engineers (India); or

Post Graduate Diploma in Management (two years).

**Desirable Educational Qualification:**

Doctorate in any discipline or Master's degree in Engineering.

Essential experience:

Joint Adviser: Minimum ten years' experience (which shall include upto three years for Ph.D provided no work experience is counted during those three years) in formulation, appraisal, execution or implementation, research, monitoring and evaluation of policy, programme or projects.

Deputy Adviser: Minimum eight years' experience (which shall include upto three years for Ph.D provided no work experience is counted during those three years) in formulation, appraisal, execution or implementation, research, monitoring and evaluation of policy, programme or projects.]
